
Inter-campus map Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University Nelson Mandela Bay





Inter-campus map **Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University** Nelson Mandela Bay



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



Vocational Education Programme



The Centre for Integrated Post-School Education and Training (CIPSET), located within the Office of Institutional Planning under the Office of the Vice-Chancellor, aims to work collaboratively with all role-players. Its approach is informed by a theory and practice of civic agency that Post-school Education and Training (PSET) is instrumental in the development of substantive democracy, citizenship and social justice.





Vocational Education Programme (VEP)

The goal of the VEP is to partially fulfil CIPSET's mission by undertaking work around various areas in order to:

- ▶ Promote an intellectual project that focuses on democracy, citizenship and social justice as central to PSET in South Africa.
- Define, develop and implement a research agenda that supports PSET in South Africa.
- Establish programmes and projects that support PSET in South Africa.
- Collaborate with educational groups, institutions and agencies in order to develop and strengthen PSET.
- Build research capacity that advances the PSET system in South Africa.
- Produce academic and scholarly work in PSET for social justice that reflects the intellectual project of CIPSET.

VEP Core Activities

Currently, the activities of the VEP revolve around the following focus areas:

Curriculum Innovation and Articulation Hub

The project's focus is to form partnerships with Technical Vocational Education and Training (TVET) colleges to facilitate the provision of admission routes and learning pathways for learners in multiple subject areas which will serve as mechanisms to aid the transition of TVET college students into academic programmes offered at the Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University.

Qualifications and Capacity Development: AET and TVET Staff

This project aims to develop academic programmes (informed by a progressive philosophical orientation) for adult educators and TVET lecturers working in various sectors of the PSET sector (TVET colleges, civil society including trade unions, CBOs and NGOs), and to provide support for these institutions and staff to enhance their knowledge and skills to accomplish their expanded mandate of providing high quality education and training.

Emerging Voices II

This project is designed to build a progressive network of researchers and community advocates. It seeks to engage and investigate communities and individuals' lived experiences about the PSET sector and their best imagination of this sector which better meets the priorities and interests of all South Africans.

Students Leadership and Governance

This programme is focused on engaging student leadership within the broader PSET sector on the role of student leaders in transforming the education and training landscape. The project aims to hold an annual convention to facilitate dialogue and research into student issues within the sector.







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
